Islington Council's Community Chest (ICCC) Annual review, June 2022

Introduction

Islington Council's Community Chest exists to support small organisations that, with local knowledge and reach, make a big difference to local residents. Islington Council's Community Chest provides small organisations with grants of up to £5,000. Priority is given to organisations that have an annual turnover of less than £50,000 and work with people who are experiencing poverty and isolation. There are three application rounds a year supporting a wide range of projects, reaching out to a diverse mix of Islington residents who typically do not access services or who have limited social networks.

Applications for Islington Council's Community Chest are considered by a panel made up of Islington Councillors, Cripplegate Foundation Governors and members of the Islington Community Network.

Groups can apply under six themes that together address local priorities and issues facing Islington residents. As the priority that attacts the least number of application, the Improving the Environment and Increasing Community Safety theme was broken down into two separate themes as a means to try and encourage more applications under each:


- Advice and support
- Educating and improving skills and employability
- Making Islington a more sustainable place to live
- Improving community safety
- Improving mental and physical health
- Reducing isolation and increasing involvement in the community

Islington Council's Community Chest actively seeks to fund projects that as a whole are inclusive of all people regardless of their age, culture, disabilities, ethnic origin, gender, nationality, race, religion or sexual orientation.

Funded groups are often reliant on local volunteers, people who are dedicated to improving their local communities and reaching out to support people in need.


Who Islington Council's Community Chest reached in 2021/2022

- 70 community groups applied to Islington Council's Community Chest in 2021-22
- 52 community groups (74% of applicants) were awarded funding, totalling grants of over £234,140
- 11 (21%) of the 52 funded groups received Islington Council's Community Chest funding for the first time
- 16 (31%) of the 52 funded groups have received 5 or more grants



Who Islington Council's Community Chest reached in 2020/2021

- 52 community groups applied to Islington Council's Community Chest in 2020-21
- 38 community groups (73% of applicants) were awarded funding, totalling grants of over £177,750
- 10 (26%) of the 38 funded groups received Islington Council's Community Chest funding for the first time
- 13 (34%) of the 38 funded groups have received 5 or more grants




As the tables above show, the ICCC Programme has picked up again quite considerably following the onset of the Coronavirus pandemic in March 2020 and subsequent related


lockdowns. Although not quite at pre-pandemic levels (80 applications in 2019/20) with 70 organisations applying for funding in 2021/22 compared to 52 for 2020/21 there has without doubt been a positive bounce back in relation to both numbers of applications received and awarded funding. Also reassuring is the proportion of successful applicants remaining at comparable levels with previous years with approximately three quarters of applications successfully receiving funding in the preceeding three years, both pre-pandemic and during the worst year and as the country has returned to some level of normality. Also, both numbers and proportion of first time applications and those that have received five or more grants remained has remained fairly buoyant comparable across years, ensuring that a good balance remains between funding new and emerging projects and longer term support.


The pie charts above also deomstrate how the programme has generally returned to a more predictable pattern in terms of the proportion of applications under each priority with the two priority areas that traditionaly receive the highest proportion of applications overall (Reducing Isolation and Improving Mental/Physical Health) increasing again in 2021/22 after a dip in 2020/21. While Advice and Support (traditionally lower numbers) has remained fairly buoyant in terms of the proportion of overall applications, Educate and Improve Skills has decreased again and is again more comparable to pre-pandemic levels. While demand for advice and wider support has continued to remain high as people suffer the ongoing consequences of the pandemic, lockdowns and rising cost of living, as children and and young people have returned to face-to-face education it is apparent that demand to help mitigate the adverse effects of lockdowns on education has receded. Despite splitting the the Improving the Environment and Increasing Community Safety theme into two separate themes focusing each on environment and community safety as a means to try and encourage more applications under each, applications under both themes have remained low during 2021/22.

Facts and figures – who we reached in 2020/21

The charts below provide a breakdown of the age, ethnicity, and gender of all people that have benefited from the support provided as a result of Islington Council's Community Chest funding over the 2020/21 period. The data is derived from returned monitoring reports so provide an accurate reflection of the work actually undertaken. The breakdowns demonstrate that the ICCC programme has good reach into BAMER communities, representing 63% of all beneficiaries compared to 32% of the overall Islington population (not including Irish/White Other). There is a good split between proportions of adult beneficiaries (65% aged 25 upwards) with just under a quarter of overall beneficiaries being older people and 35% children and young people, although it is acknowledged that there are a smaller number of projects supporting under 5s.
